Refund Policy

Classes, programs, or activities cancelled by the District are subject to a full refund. The district will issue refunds for classes, programs, or activities only if:

Withdrawals from the program will be subject to a \$5.00 administrative charge. After the class, program or activity's second meeting, no refunds will be issued except for a medical excuse with a doctor's note. Refunds will be pro-rated from the time of the request along with a \$5.00 administrative charge.
- If a friend or family member paid your registration fees and you are requesting a refund, the refund will be made out to the payer.
- No refunds will be issued for contractual classes, trips (including day), or special events after the register by date has passed. Other programs such as camp, daycare, BASP, rentals, and fitness memberships have different refund policies and are not included in the program/class/activity refund policy.
