**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A motion to approve the March 11, 2026 Regular Board Meeting Minutes and the March 11, 2026 Executive Session Minutes was made by Commissioner Stanford, seconded by Commissioner Haars. Summer equipment has been serviced and is ready to go. Playground mulch has arrived. Director Sorensen stated the Park District's final draft has been sent to Verizon.

Commission Stanford asked if more lighting could be added to the small playground area. Director Sorensen will look into it

Per the direction of the Commissioners, a notice will be posted stating effective May 1<sup>st</sup> the dog park will no longer be open to the public. The hope is to use the dog park area for additional goats and other farm animals.

Ordinance O-174 - A motion to approve and place the Tentative 2026-2027 Budget and Appropriation on file for public inspection for a period of not less than 30 days was made by Commissioner Haars, seconded by Commissioner Stanford. Upon roll call vote the following Commissioners voted aye: S. Stanford, D. Haars, D. Schott and J. Krug. With 4 ayes, 0 nays, the motion carried.
