Childcare / PFA

Childcare Director Hook stated the Daycare Center is full. Staff is busy finalizing end of the school year celebration plans. Summer camp planning is complete. A parent meeting for the summer camp program will be held Wednesday, April 17th at 6:00 pm.

Special Events and Programs

The youth basketball program and winter carnival were a huge success. The District hosted a fish fry every Friday night during the Lent season.

Upcoming spring activities include a gamer party, Mother's Day craft, Rules of the Road Course and Build a Faerie Garden.

Summer activities will include a baseball camp in June and basketball camp in July. Also, in June the District will hold an All-American Country Fair with fireworks. The annual Mudventures Jr. Fun Run will be held on August 3rd.

Adult Programs and Trips

Programs and trips offered for adults every month are the Senior's Alive luncheon, a resident luncheon, Lunch Out & About and the Four Winds Casino trip.

The annual Children's Fishing Derby will be held on Saturday June 8th.

A senior dance is planned for those ages 55+ in September.
